## Police find body of Burlington man last seen in November

WATERBURY, Vt. (AP) - Vermont police say they've found the body of a man last seen in November when he was walking into the woods near Waterbury while carrying camping equipment.

In January 40-year-old Alfred Adams of Burlington was reported missing by family members concerned for his welfare.

Burlington Police say that due to extreme weather conditions, the area where Adams was last seen could not be searched until the spring thaw.

On Monday, Burlington and state police and New England K-9 Search and Rescue searched the area along the north side of Interstate 89 near U.S. Route 2.

Adams's body was found next to a small tent encampment on a hillside overlooking the interstate.

The body was taken to the office of the Vermont Medical Examiner for autopsy.

Foul play is not suspected.
